### to the South West memorial for road crash victims

Lower Borough Walls, Bath, BA1 1QR

The memorial stone is in the very heart of Bath city centre, in a small garden on Lower Borough Walls, marked on the map overleaf. Lower Borough Walls is just a five minute walk from:

#### **Bath Spa train station**

Trains run directly to/from :

- London Paddington via Swindon & Reading
- Bristol Temple Meads with some extensions to Weston-Super-Mare
- Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour
- Southampton
- London Waterloo via Salisbury and Basingstoke (limited service)

With connecting services to:

- Westbury to Weymouth (Heart of Wessex line)
